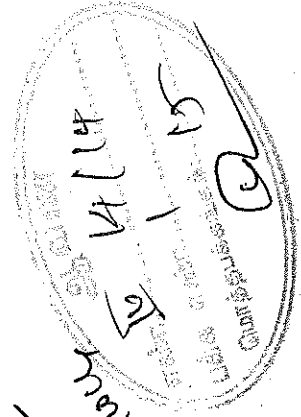

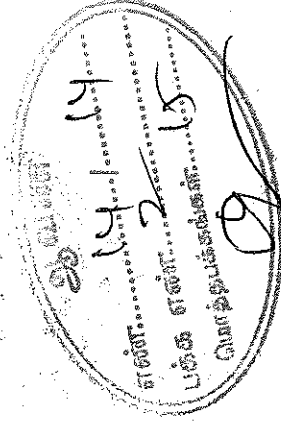

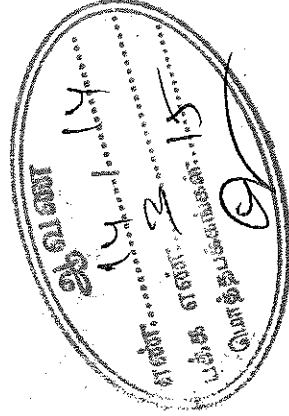

Whereas, the Founder-Author of the Trust above named herein. has been desirous of creating and establishing a Public Charitable Trust with the objects of rendering general Public Utility Service ensuring for the benefit of the Public at large.

And Whereas with a view to give effect to the said desire, he has set apart a sum of Rs.1000/- (Rupees One Thousand) only by cash TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same upon Trust for the objects described more particularly, here in, subject to the powers declared herein.

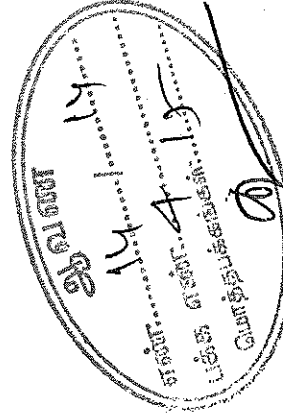
NOW THIS DEED OF TRUST WITNESSETH AND DECLARES AS FOLLOWS :

1. NAME : The Name of the Trust shall be VIVEKANANDHA TRUST. It is a social welfare, Health, Environment and Educational Trust.
2. LOCATION : The office of the Trust shall be situate for the present at 525 Sunai street, Mambattu village & post, Polur Tk. T.V.Malai Dist.606 803 TAMILNADU, INDIA. In a rented building or at any other place as the Board of Trustees deem fit and proper in accordance with the decision of the Board from time to time.

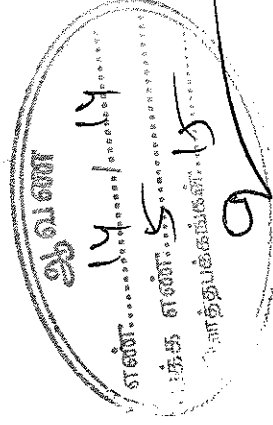
In case the Board of Trustees think it expedient , Branch Offices may be opened at such other places as the Board may decide from time to time.

3. OBJECTIVES:-

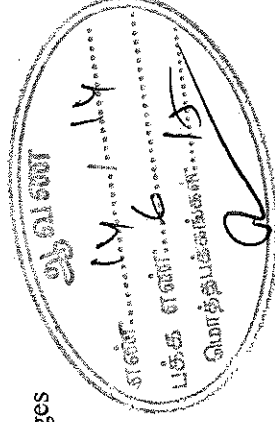
- i. To start and maintain educational institutions like Pre-Primary, High, & Higher Secondary (Both Tamil & English Medium) Schools, Computer centers, fashion designing, earing centers, food processing, polytechnics, engineering colleges, arts and science colleges, educational colleges for B.Ed and M.Ed., Paramedical colleges, Community colleges, and other Industrial Training Institute, Teacher Training Institute, Hospitality Managemet & Life resource centers, Nursing schools, Medical colleges with hostel facilities Etc., for the poor and downdrodden.



- ii. To conduct information, Education and communication activities for increasing the Awareness of population problems and family planning services among different sections of People.
- iii. To organize associations for women, youth and old people and make them get rid of Social evils like drinking, dowry systems, illiteracy, Drug addictions, against aids etc,
- iv: To conduct training programmes for youth on different vocations like dairy. Dress making, Eco forming, Typewriting etc., and help them settle down in the vocation in which they got training.
- v: To reduce maternal and infant morbidity and mortality improvement of general Health Nutrition through various service and research programmes.
- vi: To start Creches and Balwadies for infant and young Children.
- vii: To run Residential Hostels for working women. Short Stay Home for women.
- viii: To conduct research and service programmes concerning rural development and employment creations.
- ix: To run rehabilitation centers for deprived and destitute women and old people in rural and urban Areas.
- x: To run counselling centers in rural and urban areas separately to solve the social Economic and Physiological problems of people.
- xi: To foster and develop contacts with other organizations engaged in similar type of Social work in India.
- xii: To accept donations, gifts, presents, aids and grants, cash or kind movable and immovable properties from the public State and Central Governments and overseas funding agencies either as income according to the directions of the donors for purpose of carrying out the objects of the Trust.
- xiii: To do such other lawful things as are incidental and conducive to the attainment of the above objectives or any one of them.
- xiv: To take steps to improve the standard of the youth and to develop the Productivity capacity among them through Awareness, Cultural programmes play games, Scientific, Economical etc.,
- xv: To develop Rural Handicraft and Traditienal artisan's financial and economical structure. To conduct exhibition cum sales for the artisans to promote their Cultural Artistic Handicrafts and Terrakottas.
- xvi: To conduct training programmes for the development of their family welfare.



- xvii: To get all facilities from Government and Non government agencies for the development of Rural Artisans.
- xviii: To undertake wasteland development programme and convert them into productive lands and encourage youth to take active part in food productions.
- xix: Organise men & women to form self-help groups and guide them to improve their standard of living both economically and socially.
- xx: To work for the relief of those affected by fire pestilence, flood, Tsunami earth quake or other natural calamities.
- xxi: To undertake Social forestry, Nurseries and Tree plantations programmes.
- xxii: To integrate different sections of people into the development process through Educational Social and Economical activities.
- xxiii: To give Computer training, Tailoring, Mobilizes, Handicrafts, Hairing, Industrial training, Employment awareness etc., as livelihood support programs
- xxiv: To undertake the propogation of literacy through adult and non formal education programmes and projects for the purpose of achieving 100% literacy.
- xxivi: To conduct awareness programmes on Social behavior & Environmental safety to youth to make them successful citizens of the country.
- xxivii: To conduct awareness programmes against Child labour, Bonded labours.
- xxiviii: To conduct & create awareness on how to save Nature from nowadays accelerating requirements.
- xxiix: Awareness of Health & Sanitation.
- xxx: To promote rural area programs for the awareness of social needs activities, social work
- xxxi: To develop student rural people for physical education
- xxxii : To promote the education teachers, Health Medical Social workers and those in other sectors
- xxxiii: To conduct rural urban competitions.
- xxxiv: To promote Agriculture college
- xxxv: To conduct Free tuition or coaching centers
- xxxvi: To develop Asramams
- xxxvii: To offer scholarships to 10th and 12th student
- xxxviii: To develop nursing colleges



- xxxxix: To create awareness of HIV and other diseases.
- xxxx: To develop spiritual classes and spiritual centers
- xxxxxi: To conduct Free camps Veterinary medical, blood donation special welfare youth camps
- xxxxxii: To enable the free hospital and mobile hospital services
- xxxxxx: To conduct agricultural training programmes for rural areas.

BANK ACCOUNT:

The bank account/s on behalf of the Trust can be opened in any bank/s and be operated by The PRESIDENT TRUSTEE, EITHER WITH THE TREASURER OR SECRETARY. In absence of the President Trustee or during his stay in out of station, the President Trustee is empowered to authorize the Secretary and the Treasurer to operate the bank account/s on his written concurrence to the bank/s and by passing such an appropriate board resolution.

4. DECLARATION OF POLICY

The trust shall ensure for the benefit of the general public that no person shall be entitled to any benefit or service merely by virtue of his/her castes, creed, community race, religion or sex.

5. VESTING OF THE PROPERTIES OF THE TRUST

The properties of the Trust shall be.

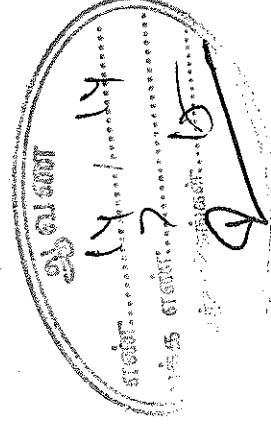
- a. The said sum of Rs.1000/- (Rupees One thousand only) above referred to the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged by the Trustees.
- b. Any properties movables or immovables that may be acquired by purchase or otherwise in favour of the Trust.
- c. All additions and accretions to the Trust Fund
- d. All voluntary donations both towards, corpus and otherwise, gifts, legacies or grants in cash or in kind of the Trust

6. CREATIONS OF THE TRUST.

The founder and Author Mr.D.Balu herein above referred to has endowed a sum of Rs.1000/- (Rupees One thousand only) to the Trust.

7. CONSTITUTION

The Number of the Trustees shall be Five at present. The Board of Trustees shall at present be Consisting of the following persons who shall be Trustees for their lives or during pleasure.

8. MANAGEMENT:

The day today conduct and Management of the affairs of the Trust shall be carried on by the Managing Trustee who is also authorized to delegate all or any other powers to other Trustees.

9. ADMINISTRATION:

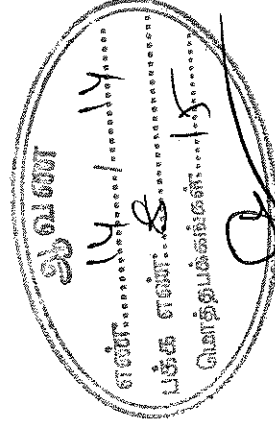
The Trust shall be administered by the Board of Trustees listed in above Serial No 7 paragraph.

DECLARATION GENERAL

- A. The Founder-Author above named hereby makes it clear that the Trust is irrevocable.
- B. The Trust shall functions for the benefit of all persons irrespective of caste, creed, race, religion, region or sex.
- C. Any amendment made to this Trust shall be carried out with the approval of the commissioner of Income-Tax
- D. The Fund of the trust shall be invested in accordance with the provisions of section 11(5) read, 12A, 80 G, with in section 13(1) (d) of the Income –Tax Act.

10. RULES AND REGULATIONS:

It shall be lawful for the Trustees from time to time to frame such rules and regulations for the management and administration of the Trust and its institutions as well as the trust funds as they shall think fit and to alter or vary the same from time to time and make new rules and regulations provided



that such and rules and regulations shall not be inconsistent with the powers, objects of the Trust, terms & conditions and intents of these persents.

11. DURATION OF OFFICE OF TRUSTEES

- a. D.Balu shall be The Managing Trustee and shall hold office for his life or Until he resignes.
- b. The other Trustees shall hold office for three years or until they resign are terminated. They are eligible to be re-elected.

12. POWERS TO COOPT

The Trustees shall have powers to coopt additional Trustees or to fill up any vacancy in the Board of Trustees however, that the total number of Trustees shall not be below Five.

13. VACANCIES OCCURRING IN THE OFFICE OF THE TRUSTEES

The vacancies occurring in the office of the Trustees shall be filled by the remaining Trustees within 3 months of the arising of such vacancies. If there are no Trustees functioning at any point of time, the Trustees shall be appointed in accordance with the law by a Court of Competent jurisdiction. Where at any time the number of Trustees falls below the minimum number of three the continuing Trustees shall have the powers to coopt any person or persons to fill up such vacancies.

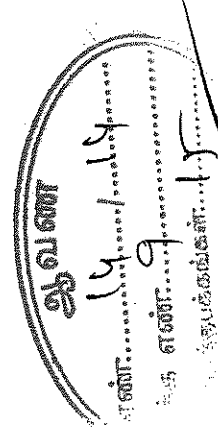
14. VACANCY NOT TO INVALID THE PROCEEDINGS

Any vacancy in the board of Trustees and / or any illegality in the appointment of Trustees their Proceedings shall not invalidate any prior arrived decisions, if the Trustee may at any time by Writing under his hand resign his office, in that case the other Trustees are empowered to appoint other Suitable person in his place as a Trustee and fill up such vacancy caused by resignation.

15. PROCEEDINGS OF THE TRUSTEES:

The Board of Trustees may meet as often as may be necessary for the efficient conduct of the Trust. The QUORUM for the meeting of the Board of Trustees shall be three. The Trustees may take decision On any matter either at their meeting or by circulations or resolutions on papers. The Trustees entrusted shall maintain accurate and upto date records of all the resolutions passed by the Board of Trustees. If any of the Trustees is absent at any three consecutive Board Meetings without prior leave of absence approved by the boards, he shall be deemed to have vacated his office. However such absence may be condoned under extraordinary circumstances if thought fit and found reasonable by the Boards of Trustees by a resolution passed at their meeting.

16. VOTING:



Each Trustee shall have the right to vote. The opinion/decision of the majority of the Board of Trustees shall be final on the basis of the attendance of the number of trustees at a meeting in respect of all Matters relating to the trust.

17. MINUTES ACCOUNTS AND AUDIT:

The Managing Trustee shall maintain correct accounts regularly, and every year the accounts shall be closed by 31st March and the same shall be audited by a qualified charter account. The accounting year of the trust shall be from 1st April to 31st March of the year.

18. NET INCOME OF TRUST.

The Trustees shall invest and recover the Income of the Trust fund and shall provide for all costs Charges incidental expenses. Including Insurance Premium and expenses of ordinary repairs etc. and all other outgoing and expenses for the management and administration of the Trust.

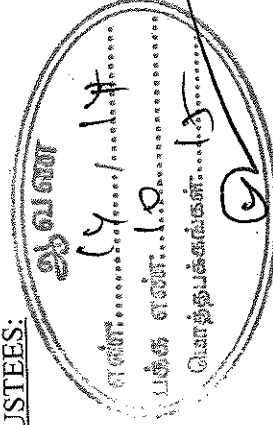
19. AREA OF ACTIVITIES:

It is hereby declared that the objects / activities of the trust shall be carried out only in India.

20. APPLICATION OF INCOME AND TRUST FUND:

- a) The Trustees shall after providing for the aforesaid payments and disbursements and after setting apart any sum for sinking fund or reserves etc apply and utilize the net income or the corpus of the Trust or the Trust fund for the fulfillment of all or any of the charitable purposes or their absolute and unfettered discretion determine.
- b) The income and funds of the trust will solely be utilized towards the objects and no portion of it will be utilized for payment to the trustees / office bearers by way of profit / divided interest etc. The powers vested on the Board of Trustees on the amendments of Trust Deed would not extend to altering the basic character / objects of the Trust and further no such amendments which may prove to be repugnant to the provisions of sections 25(15), 11, 12 & 13 and 80G of Income Tax Act.
- c) The trust will not function in the nature of conducting a business activity and not for the purpose of profit and the trust will abide and satisfy the conditions stipulated in section 11(4) and provision to section 80G(5)(i) of the Income tax Act. In the event of dissolution / winding of the trust the assets remaining as on the date of the dissolution Shall under no circumstances be distributed among the trustees but the same shall be transferred to another charitable trust whose objects are similar to those of this trust and which enjoys recognition under section 80G of the Income Tax Act.

21. LIABILITY OF TRUST OR TRUSTEES:



In the professed execution of the Trust and the powers conferred the Directors shall be liable for the loss of the Trust properties arising by reason of improper investment made in good faith on for the negligence or fraud by the Trustees here of although the employment of such a measure shall not strictly be necessary or expedient or by reason of any mistake or mission made in good faith by the Trustees or reason of any other matter except willful or deliberate fraud on the part of the Trustees which alone may be subject to be made so liable.

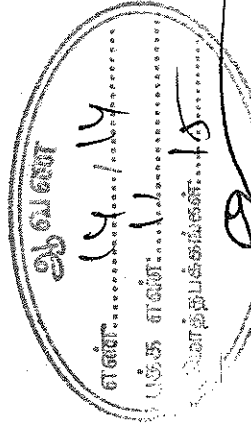
22. INDEMNITY:

The Trustees shall be kept fully indemnified and harmless by the Trust against any loss or liability arising there for anything done by them in good faith pursuant to the power and authority Conferred on them by these persents.

23. POWER OF TRUSTEES:

Without prejudice to the general powers of the Trustees to manage the Trust, the managing Trustee shall have the following powers for the management and administration of the Trust and for the management and execution of the objects of the Trust.

- (a) To keep the Trust properties or apply the Trust funds for the acquisition of any kind of property or assets whatsoever , including movable, auctionable claims, securities, shares stocks or anyother form of property.
- (b) To open one or more nationalized bank accounts in the name of the Trust and for the Trust anywhere in India and the persons authorised by the Board of Trustees viz. The Managing Trustee herein shall have the power to operate such bank accounts.
- (c) To invest funds of the Trust, any movable or immovable property in any part of the country (In India) and further the managing trustee herein, shall have the power to sale or vary such investments according to the discretion of the Board of Trustees from time to time. Provided also however, the decision adopted by the Board unanimously or by majority of the Trustees voting shall prevail and be final.
- (d) The Managing Trustee shall maintain proper books of account of the money. Properties income and expenditure of the Trust which shall be audited every year by a Chartered Accountant duly appointed for the purpose.
- (e) The Trustees shall have the powers to collect rent interest or other income and investment. The Trust fund and any such investment from time to time and shall realize the investment for the purpose

of the Trust, However the Trustees shall have limited powers of mortgage, raise loans or encumber sell or lease out for a period exceeding one year otherwise alienate the immovable properties, If any of the Trust Unless and until necessity or occasion compels such a sale transfer or encumbrance or other alienation of the immovable properties in any such event, the Managing Trustee shall be competent to sell, lease encumber or otherwise alienate the properties of the Trust, after due authorization by the Board of Trustees.

(f) To do all such acts and things as necessary for the control and management of the affairs of the Trust and for the purpose of the attainment of the objects of the Trust.

(g) To raise such loans for the benefit of the Trust and to sign such promissory notes, bills of exchange, Hundies or other financial documents that may be necessary for and on behalf of the Trust.

(h) To settle, compromise or compound all or any of the debts, claims, outstanding amounts, disputes, demands, action suits and proceedings, whatsoever by or against in any manner relating to the Trust or refer the same to arbitration.

(i) To lend or invest the surplus funds of the Trust in such manner as may be decided by the Board of Trustees.

(j) To incur all such expenses as are necessary for the execution of the Trust and powers under these presents.

(k) To raise donations or accept gifts or contributions in each or in kind.

(l) To appoint Auditors to audit the accounts of the Trust.

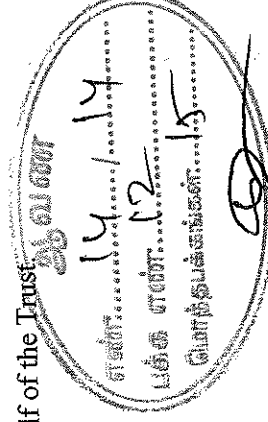
(m) To appoint legal advisors for the Trust.

(n) To appoint such staff as may be necessary for the due administration of the Trust on such remuneration. Commission or salary as the Trustees may think proper and suspend remove or replace any or all of them whenever necessary.

(o) To reimburse the Trustees towards the out of pockets expenses which may be incurred by them in the course of or in relation to the affairs of the Trust.

(p) To receive donations contributions, request legacies and endowment from individuals Charitable or other trust or institutions of Government and Non-Government for the objects of the Trust on such terms and conditions as may be accepted by the Trustees.

(q) The Managing Trustee shall manage the affairs of the Trust on behalf of the Board of Trustees shall be the person to sue or be sued on behalf of the Trust.



(f) To make alter rescind, any rule & regulation in regard to the conduct of the affairs of Trust in respect of which any power or duty vested in them for the convenient and effective management and administration of the Trust.

24. ACCEPTANCE BY TRUSTEES:

The Trustees have accepted to act as Trustees of the Trust subject to all terms rights duties and obligations set in this Trust Deed.

The activities of the Trust would be purely of Social Service Nature and Not Motivated For Profit

AT PRESENT THE TRUST DOES NOT OWN ANY MOVABLE OR IMMOVABLE PROPERTY.

THE TRUST IS AN INDIGENOUS ONE.

THE TRUST IS IRREVOCABLE

IN ALL OTHER RESPECTS, INDIAN TRUST ACT, 1882, SHALL APPLY TO THE TRUST.
